On Wednesday 5th July, the Infant school will be hosting their Sports' Day carousel of events across the morning. It would be great if you could attend to support and encourage all participants in this enjoyable occasion. We are looking to begin at approximately 9:30am and finish at approximately 11:30.

The children will compete in their class groups and collect points for their house team – **Ranworth**, **Barton**, **Hickling** and **Filby**. Classes will be prompted to move to the next activity by the Headteacher at appropriate times signified by a whistle/bell being sounded.

The five stations are (see map)

Flat, straight sprint race on the bottom field.

Bean bag throw on the playground.


Over and under tunnel ball on the playground.
