
We have lots for you to enjoy laid on by the staff and by visiting stall holders.

Please see the attached map to help guide you around where certain things can be roughly located. Please ensure you are vigilant on the car park, as staff and stall holders will need access to it during the afternoon.

Hot dogs, bacon rolls and drinks are being prepared and served from our kitchen servery in the Hall.

We are encouraging our families attending to come with smaller dominations of change rather than larger notes, as most of our stalls are 50p/£1.00.

We are asking all school-age children to use the Years 4, 5 and 6 toilets, but adults and any very young children requiring their adult to assist them need to use the disabled toilet. All toilets are to be accessed through the Hall only, as all outside class doors will be closed. For safeguarding reasons, adults are not to use the children's male and female toilets.



We are hoping poor weather will not spoil the occasion, but if the weather continues to be forecast as rainy, please ensure you are all prepared for and protected against this. We are unable to rearrange this event to another date, so if rain does occur some of our stalls may need to be moved inside, into our Hall.
