Dear Parents and Carers,

17th June 2026

On Wednesday 1st July, the Infant school will be holding their Sports' Day of events across the day. We are going to be organising this differently this year to make the management of the occasion much easier and safer for pupils, staff and parents involved.

The variety of field events (jumping and throwing etc.) will take place across the morning and in the afternoon the children will participate in a selection of track events on our main field.

It would be great if you could attend to support and encourage all participants when they take part in their track events in the **afternoon only**. We are looking to begin at approximately 2:00pm and finish at approximately 3:00pm. Children will then return to classes with staff safely to gather their belongings before being collected by their family members at the end of the school day to go home. Parents can move to their normal pick up locations, once the children have gone in.

When families arrive, we would like everyone to follow the designated route (see the red arrows on the map enclosed) and find a seat in the family area. Once the event has finished, please exit the field using the same entrance pathway. Photographs and videos can be taken, but we ask that no content is shared over social media or the Internet. Personal use only.

The children will compete in their class groups and collect points for their house team - **Ranworth**, **Barton**, **Hickling** and **Filby**.

In the afternoon, each class will take turns at competing in the various different events on the track in front of parents, who will all be within a family area, which will run along the length of the track. For the safety of the children, all families must remain in this area at all times. Pupils will stay with their staff throughout the events so staff know exactly where they are. If any pupil needs the toilet, staff will be there to ensure this is facilitated. If any parent needs the toilet, please use the two portaloos provided. If any pre-school age sibling needs the toilet they must be accompanied by an adult and use the portaloos also. School toilets will only be available during the event for our school pupils and staff.



All children involved will be organised under class gazebos to prepare for each track race and staff will ensure everyone gets to participate. Children should come to school in their school PE kit with suitable footwear for racing. If the weather is going to be hot and bright, please ensure the children have sunhats, suncream applied and a drink bottle to keep them hydrated. However, please keep an eye on the weather forecast - things can be quite unpredictable at this time of year. The PA system will announce each different race and any notices during the event.

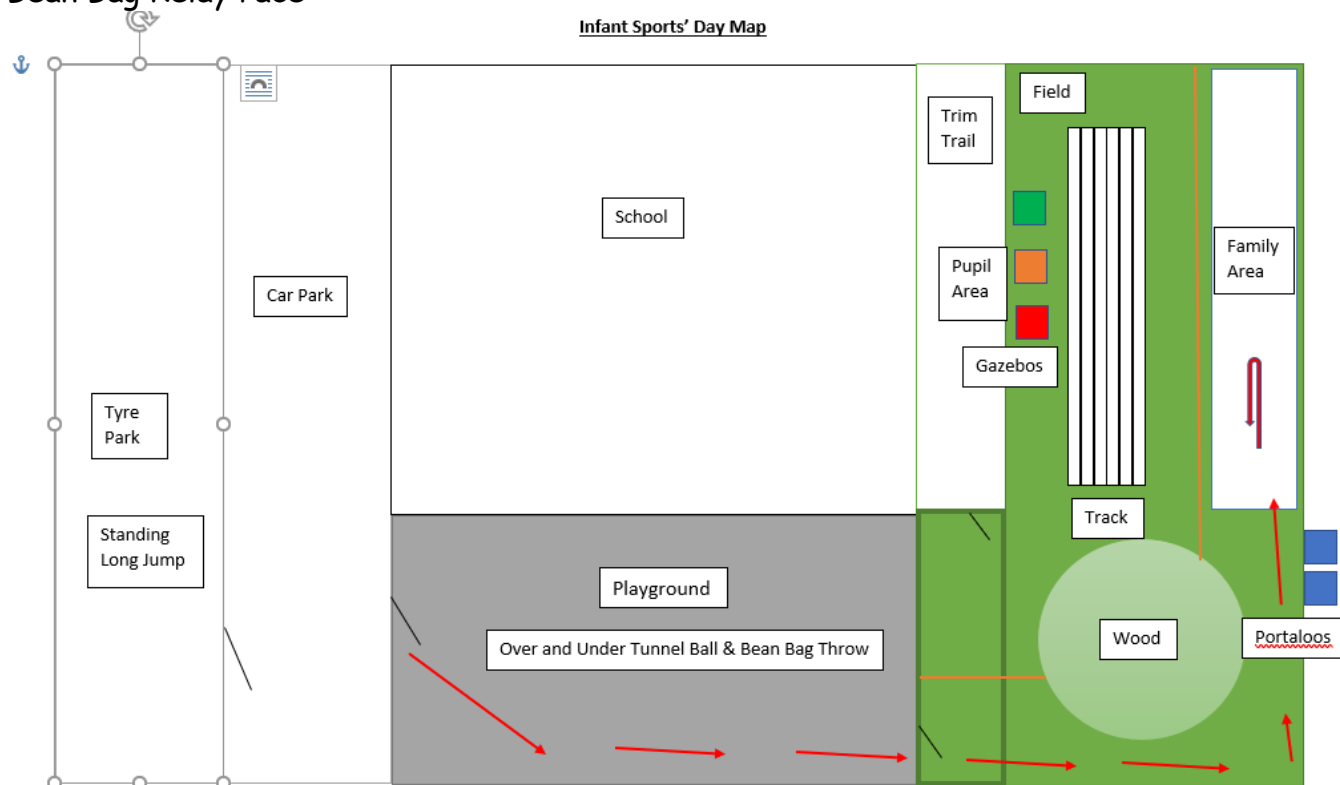
Obstacle course race
